Job Descriptions

<u>Cabinet Maker:</u> The Cabinet Maker is responsible for constructing cabinetry, furniture, and other interior and exterior components for Delta's yachts.

- Fabricating cabinetry, furniture, tooling, and other interior and exterior components out of hardwood, plywood, and other material.
- Set up and operate variety of stationary woodworking machines including table saws, band saws, edge banders, etc.
- Operate variety of handheld woodworking tools including routers, saws, staple gun, drills, drivers, etc.

<u>CDL-A Driver</u>: The Driver is responsible for picking up and delivering material around the Puget Sound area in our tractor trailer and/or Ford F-450.

- CDL A license is required.
- Depending on other skills/experience, you could be helping out maintenance, mechanics, carpenter, or warehouse.
- This full-time position is local and you will be home every night.
- When not delivering material, this position will help out with the warehouse and inventory control.

<u>Dock Hand</u>: The Dock Hand is responsible for assisting with the moving of vessels around the yard, pressure washing and cleaning yachts, and assisting tradesmen with various tasks around the yard.

- Assisting with moving boats including setting up Marine Travelift and rigging, staging, and placing blocking and stanchions to secure the vessel, moving and securing boarding ramps, assisting with boat moorage lines, assisting other trades with their work.
- Pressuring washing vessels as they leave the water, and processing wash water.
- General clean up and housekeeping of work areas and on boats.
- Moves, secures, loads and unloads materials.

<u>Electrician</u>: The Electrician is responsible for assembling, installing, testing, and repairing electrical systems and components on Delta's yachts.

- Assemble, install, test, and maintain electrical or electronic wiring, equipment, controls, appliances, fixtures, lighting, audio/visual, low voltage systems, etc.
- Creating and installing wireways and raceways in overheads, bulkheads, walls, and other areas of the boat.
- Tests, troubleshoots, repairs, and replaces damaged or nonfunctioning items.

<u>Fiberglass Laminator</u>: The Fiberglass Laminator is responsible for using composites and fiberglass to construct hulls, superstructure, house sides, decks and other fiberglass and composite parts for Delta's yachts.

- Fabricating composite hulls and parts using either hand lay-up techniques or vacuum infusion methods.
- Setting up and preparing molds, tooling and other surfaces for lay-up process; including release agents, composite material, vacuum bagging materials, etc.
- Mixing and dispensing resins and other materials according to Delta standard specifications.

• Grinding, sanding and trimming completed fiberglass parts.

<u>Mechanic:</u> The Mechanic is responsible for constructing, installing and repairing mechanical systems on Delta's yachts.

- Fabricating and installing various mechanical systems including; hydraulic, pneumatic, fuel, water systems, HVAC, plumbing, metal fabrication, steering systems, and many other mechanical systems.
- Fabricating and installing technical spaces including engine room, cranes, elevators, etc.
- Installation of appliances and mechanical components.
- Safe operation of a variety of equipment and handheld tools including powered, pneumatic, hydraulic, vibratory, and hand tools.

<u>Yacht Painter</u>: The yacht painter is responsible for preparing, sanding, fairing and applying paint coatings onto metal, wood, and fiberglass yacht hulls and parts.

- Sanding of exterior and interior yacht parts and hulls.
- Applying fairing compound to various yacht parts and hulls.
- Spraying, rolling or brushing of primers, stains, paints, and other coatings on various yacht parts and hulls.
- Preparatory work for paint, including but not limited to; building tents, applying masking tape, applying paint overspray protection, setting up ventilation, etc.
